


ON-VEHICLE INSPECTION



1. CHECK PARKING BRAKE LEVER TRAVEL Pull the parking brake lever all the way up, and count the number of clicks. Parking brake lever travel at **196 N** (**20 kgf**, **44.1 lbs**) : **5 - 8 clicks** If incorrect, adjust the <u>parking brake</u>.



- 2. IF NECESSARY, ADJUST <u>PARKING BRAKE</u> **HINT:** Before adjusting the <u>parking brake</u>, make sure that the rear <u>brake shoe</u> clearance has been adjusted.
 - a. Remove the console box.
 - b. Loosen the lock nut and turn the adjusting nut until the lever travel is correct.
 - c. Tighten the lock nut. Torque: 5.4 Nm (55 kgf-cm, 48 inch lbs.)
 - d. Install the console box.
